

TYPES OF PEER PRESSURE

Positive Peer Pressure - When someone urges you to do something that is good for you.

Friendly Peer Pressure - When someone who is your friend tries to get you to do something you may or may not want to do.

Indirect/Tempting - When someone tries to persuade or convince you to do something you do not want to do.

Teasing - When someone makes fun of you to try to get you to do something you do not want to do.

Heavy Peer Pressure/ Bullying - When someone threatens you, physically or verbally, in an attempt to get you to do something you do not want to do.
